VIOLATORS WILL BE PROSECUTED

3-30-B: UNLAWFUL TRESPASS, MISREPRESENTATION: It is hereby declared to be the policy of the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Glen Ellyn that the occupant or occupants of the residences in the Village shall make the determination of whether solicitors shall be, or shall not be, invited to their respective residences.

- (A) Every person desiring to secure the protection intended to be provided by this Ordinance shall give notice of his determination to refuse to invite solicitors to the residence by exhibiting a weather proof card, decal or sign, not less than three inches by four inches (3" x 4") in size, upon or near the main entrance, point of approach or entry to the residence, containing the words "NO SOLICITORS INVITED", the letters of which
 - A) shall be at least one-third inch (1/3") in height, and, for the purpose of uniformity, cards shall be provided by the Police Department to persons requesting them at the cost thereof. Such card, decal or sign so exhibited shall constitute sufficient notice to any solicitor that he is prohibited from trespassing upon the premises.
- (B) It is hereby declared to be unlawful, and shall constitute a trespass, for any person to go upon any premises and ring the doorbell, or create any sound in any other manner calculated to attract the attention of the occupant of such residence, for the purpose of securing an audience with the occupant thereof and engage in soliciting, in defiance of the notice exhibited at the residence, in accordance with the provisions of this Ordinance.
- (C) It shall be unlawful for any person engaged in soliciting to use sales or other tactics based on force, threat of force, intimidation or psychological pressure; to knowingly misrepresent himself or herself or their product to any Village official, or potential or actual contributor, or to make or cause to be made any contract, order form or instrument of indebtedness without full knowledge of the contributor.

3-23-9: HOURS OF OPERATION: No peddling shall be permitted within the Village before the hour of nine o'clock (9:00) A.M. or after the hour of eight o'clock (8:00) P.M., and no peddling shall be conducted on Sundays except that licensed mobile ice cream vendors shall be permitted to peddle within the Village on Sundays between the hours of nine o'clock (9:00) A.M. and eight o'clock (8:00) P.M. (Ord. 4155, 6-27-94)

3-23-10: SIGNS AT VILLAGE LIMITS: The Public Works Director is hereby directed to post appropriate signs at the limits of the Village with the following language:

PEDDLERS MUST BE LICENSED AND REGISTERED. APPLY AT GLEN ELLYN MUNICIPAL BUILDING, 535 DUANE STREET. (Ord. 2198, 5-23-77)

3-23-11: PENALTY, CONFLICTING ORDINANCES: Any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be fined in an amount not exceeding five hundred dollars (\$500.00) for each such offense.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed. (Ord. 2198, 5-23-77)

3-23-12: VALIDITY OF ORDINANCE: If any section, subsection, paragraph or part of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid by any final court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity or effectiveness of the remaining portions of this Ordinance. (Ord. 2198, 5-23-77)

3-23-13: UNLAWFUL PEDDLING: It shall be unlawful for any person to stand on or within any street located within the corporate limits of the Village for the purpose of engaging in the business of peddling with the occupant of any vehicle. (Ord. 2442, 3-26-79)

3-23-14: ADDITIONAL CONDITIONS: Sales by a peddler within the Village shall be subject to the following additional conditions:

- (A) Vehicles must be operated in a manner as not to interfere with traffic.
- (B) The sale of products is to be made from the right curb side of the vehicle and only when legally parked.

- (C) Sale of products to any person standing on the roadway is prohibited.
- (D) The use of electronic sound amplification equipment is prohibited.
- (E) Peddling within one thousand feet (1,000') of any grade school, junior high school or high school within the Village is prohibited while the school is in session, thirty (30) minutes before assemblage or within thirty (30) minutes of dismissal.
- (F) Mobile ice cream peddling is prohibited at all times on the streets listed in Section 9-9-17; Schedule Q; Peddling Prohibited at all Times. (Ord. 4155, 6-27-94)
