

Duane/Lorraine Parking Lot to Close for Resurfacing


Commuters, residents and visitors to Glen Ellyn please take note that the Duane/Lorraine Parking Lot, located west of the Glen Ellyn Public Library parking lot, will be closed for a two week span for resurfacing. The closure will occur beginning next **Wednesday, October 11 through October 25**.

The Village will now offer alternative parking options to users impacted by the Duane/Lorraine closure.

- the Main & Crescent Metra Lot (3 hr. metered spaces) SE corner of Main & Crescent
- on **residential** streets bordered by Anthony (north), Montclair (east), Hillside (south) and Glenwood (west)

In addition, other communities may be an option for commuters that travel before 11am. Those who use the lot after 11am are welcome to park in other Glen Ellyn commuter lots.
