BANK ROBBERY

On September 29, 2017 at approximately 9:30 AM Glen Ellyn Police Officers responded to the Bank of America at 600 Roosevelt Road, Glen Ellyn for the report of a bank robbery. Employees reported that a man entered the bank, announced a robbery and demanded money from the teller. The teller complied and gave the man an undetermined amount of currency. The offender fled on foot eastbound from the bank. Officers searched the area, but were unable to locate anyone matching the description provided by witnesses.

The suspect is described as a white male in his mid-forties, 5'08" tall with a medium build; wearing light colored plaid pants, a blue sweatshirt, a purple wig with a knit hat and women's sunglasses.
