***GLEN ELLYN POLICE INVESTIGATING CRASH INVOLVING PEDESTRIAN***

On Thursday, August 24, 2017 at approximately 8:30 P.M. Glen Ellyn Police responded to investigate a crash involving a vehicle and a pedestrian at the intersection of Park Boulevard and Harding Avenue. Investigation revealed that the pedestrian, an 84-year-old Glen Ellyn man, was crossing Park from west to east when he was struck by a northbound vehicle being driven by a 54-year-old man from Minnesota. The pedestrian was taken by ambulance to Good Samaritan Hospital where he remains today.

The DuPage County Accident Reconstruction Team is assisting with the investigation which is on-going. There were no indications that drugs or alcohol were a factor in the crash. Park Boulevard was closed to traffic in the area for about three hours while investigators processed the scene.
