- While Village facilities, including the Civic Center, Public Works and both Fire Stations are closed to the public, we want to remind residents and businesses that all Village departments remain available via email or phone. - The Village is adhering to State restrictions prohibiting indoor dining at local restaurants. This is a crucial time for our small business owners, especially restaurants.
