

Village Board to Meet Regarding COD

The public is cordially invited to a public input/information session regarding the Village's working relationship with the College of DuPage on Monday, June 6, 2011. The College and the Village have been working together for over a year to pen a new Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA) since the College canceled the last one in December 2008.

After the College's Board passed a version of the IGA on April 28th, the Glen Ellyn Village Board tabled passage of the agreement on May 16th due to the overwhelming public request for more time to review the agreement and for information from the College and the Village regarding the IGA. The College Board then rescinded its approval of the agreement and voted to de-annex from the Village on May 23rd.

The Village remains committed to a successful working relationship with the College of DuPage. The Village also remains committed to providing the public with the information requested regarding this situation and the opportunity to contribute educated opinion and solution suggestions.

At the June 6th meeting, the Village Board, with the public's participation, will discuss its goals of safety and taxpayer cost-savings and options for the future with regard to the College's admirable development initiatives. College officials have also been invited to the meeting. The session starts at 7 p.m. in the Galligan Board Room on the third floor of the Glen Ellyn Civic Center.
