Regular Refuse	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Year Round - Every Monday (except holidays) 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - 1 wheeled refuse cart each week; any additional bags and/or containers up to 33 gallons and 50 lbs. require 1 Refuse sticker each. - Bulk items and appliances require 1 Refuse sticker each. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Pink "Refuse" stickers
Recycling	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Year Round - Every Monday (except holidays) 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Wheeled recycling cart (35 and 65 gallon sizes) for glass & metal containers, aerosol cans, plastics #1 through #5, and #6 (except foamed polystyrene) (including plastic rings, juice boxes, milk and juice cartons), newspaper and mixed paper, recyclable paperboard items (food boxes, etc.) and corrugated cardboard (no larger than 3-feet square). - Paper and other recyclables can be co-mingled. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - No stickers needed
Yard Waste & Leaves	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Begins in April and ends in November. - Sometimes end date may be extended if weather permits. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - All cans/bags(not plastic) of yard waste require 1 sticker each. - Yard waste can be contained in brown paper bags (not plastic) and/or unlined 33 gallon trash containers, placed separately from regular refuse with stickers facing the street - Sod is not yard waste and should be disposed of as refuse - Branch and brush can also be put out for this pick-up. Branch and brush should be in bags, cans or bundled with twine, each bundle requires 1 yard waste sticker. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Green "Yard Waste" stickers
Branch & Brush	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Pick-up from mid-May until mid-October. - Residents living on or north of Hill have pick-up the 2nd Monday of the month. - Residents south of Hill have pick up the 3rd Monday of the month. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Material should <u>NOT</u> be bundled or otherwise containered. - Branches may not exceed 10-inches in diameter. Also, no root balls, dimensional lumber or any material exceeding the 10-inch dimension. - There is no length limit on branches (longer the better). - There is no limit to amount. - Professionally cut trimmings are not included. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - No stickers needed
Clean Sweep	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Every-Other Year (even-numbered years) 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - See Village Newsletter for details. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - No stickers needed

Waste and Recycling Guide

August 1, 2005 to July 31, 2012

The Village of Glen Ellyn has awarded a two-year contract extension through July 31, 2012 (from the original five-year contract) to Allied Waste Services (formerly BFI) for weekly refuse, recycling and yard waste collection. The Village also offers monthly brush & branch collection May through October. Weekly refuse/recycling collections occur on Mondays (or Tuesday, if Monday is a holiday) and allows for unlimited amounts of recyclables in wheeled carts and one wheeled refuse cart per week without a sticker. Recycling carts are available in 35 and 65 gallon sizes and refuse carts are available in 35, 65, and 95 gallon sizes. While your wheeled refuse cart is paid through your monthly Village water bill, any additional refuse containers, or any yard waste containers (not to exceed 33-gallon/50-pound maximum) must be stickered. The two distinct stickers, (refuse and yard waste), identify where the hauler should take the various types of collections. Yard waste stickers should also be used for removal of leaves.

Rear door collection is also available for an additional monthly charge. Senior citizens enjoy discounted monthly rates for curbside pick-up or rear door service for 35 gallon wheeled carts. Current pricing can be viewed online at www.glenellyn.org

Most items are recyclable. However, the following cannot be recycled through the weekly pick up:

- Plastic grocery bags
- Packing material/packing peanuts
- Crystal
- Light bulbs
- Ceramics
- Glass (except recyclable glass bottles/jars)
- Foamed Polystyrene (Styrofoam)
- Non-rinsed containers with food residue
