Illinois Home Weatherization Assistance Program (IHWAP)

Provides a diagnostic test to income eligible households to aid in lowering the cost of utilities. Energy saving measures provided may include sealing cracks with weather-strip and caulk, insulating walls and attics, and repairing or replacing windows and doors. IHWAP checks each furnace for safety, and when needed, repairs, updates, cleans and tunes to provide optimum efficiency. The furnace is replaced if found



to be unsafe or non-repairable. Smoke detectors, carbon monoxide detectors and fire extinguishers are installed in homes without them.

Households who qualify for the Weatherization Program are also eligible for the Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP), which assists eligible households in paying for winter heating services. Accommodations are available to assist seniors and the homebound apply for Weatherization and LIHEAP services.

Who Is Eligible?

You may be eligible to receive assistance if your household's combined income is at or below the following levels:

American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 (ARRA)

The Federal stimulus package, or American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 (ARRA) will appropriate \$43 billion dollars for



investments in energy, including the Weatherization Assistance Program. IHWAP is funded by the U.S. Department of Energy (DOE), the U.S. Department of Health and

Human Services (HHS), and the state supplemental Energy Assistance Fund. The American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 is providing a large increase in DOE Weatherization funds. This funding will allow many more low-income Illinois homes to be weatherized over the next two years. Weatherization services are provided by local community action agencies, or not-for-profit agencies through the state.
